

Facilitating Questions

In ST Math®, the puzzles start off simple and then get more challenging as the student progresses. When they reach a challenging problem, they may ask for your help.

To help them, ask questions like:

- **What do you notice about the puzzle?**
- **What do you think you have to do to solve the puzzle?**
- **What things can you click on?**
- **Describe the strategy that you are going to use.**
- **What do you expect to happen when you try your strategy?**
- **Describe what you see after you try your strategy. Was it what you expected?**
- **What did you learn?**
- **How will you use what you learned?**

If your child continues to be stuck and does not know what to do, have them play a previous level. Ask, "What did you learn from the previous level that can help you in this new level?"



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
